1. ABOUT THIS MANUAL

Published in 2022, the Sports Technical Manuals provide detailed information on each sports competition and discipline at XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, as well as operational information that may be of interest to participating teams.

Each manual includes:

- An introduction to San Salvador and Games 2023.
- Sport-specific information, such competition schedule and format, training and qualification criteria.
- Operational information on accreditation.

While this information is correct as of the date of publication, it may vary according to the updates provided by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), the International Federation (IF) or Centro Caribe Sports (CCS). Therefore, National Olympic Committees (NOCs) should visit the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com for updated information.

2. ABOUT SAN SALVADOR

San Salvador is the capital and largest city of the Republic of El Salvador and one of the most populous cities in Central America. Located in one of the fourteen departments of the nation, specifically in the department of San Salvador, houses the three branches of government, the main companies of economy, development, telecommunications, embassies, hotels, Presidential House of El Salvador, the main museums of the country, residential, economic, and commercial areas, monuments, and the main headquarters of economic services, political, fashion, art, and development of El Salvador.

San Salvador is located at 670 meters above sea level. It is bordered to the north by the municipalities of Nejapa, Mejicanos, Cuscatancingo, and Ciudad Delgado, to the east by Soyapango, to the south by Panchimalco and San Marcos, and to the west by Antigua Cuscatlán and Santa Tecla.

The geography of the Salvadoran capital is dominated by two great orographic prominences, which make the landscape of the capital unmistakable, since they can be observed from any point of the city: the San Salvador Volcano and the San Jacinto Hill. The first is composed of two large formations: El Picacho, with a height

of 1959.97 masl; and the other, El Boquerón, the most voluptuous formation, at 1839.39 masl, which has a huge crater of 1.5 km in diameter. This volcano is representative of the city, to the point that it basically forms its skyline, paling to any other structure built by human hands in the city, perhaps that is the reason why despite a certain real estate boom that the town has experienced since the late 1990s, no structure has become an icon of the city, except for the historic buildings. The second most representative orographic structure of this municipality is the San Jacinto Hill, which has a height of 1100 meters above sea level and which until a few years ago had a cable car at its peak. The mentioned Volcano of San Salvador is located to the west of the city, while the San Jacinto Hill is located to the southeast. These two natural watchtowers frame the valley in which San Salvador is located. The city has a warm climate all year round, being December, January and February the coolest months. Temperatures remain between 18 °C and 33 °C. The hottest months are March, April and May. From May to October is the rainy season when flooding usually occurs.

Temperatures vary between noon and midnight due to changes in humidity levels. The highest temperature recorded in San Salvador has been 38.5 °C, the lowest 4.0 °C

5. PLACE AND DATE OF COMPETITION

The Archery competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, will take place from July 2nd to July 7th, 2023, at the Archery Polygon "Jorge Jimenez", at Ciudad Merliot Sports Center.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, athletes must abide by the (CCS) statute and (FITA) rules and must be duly registered by their NOC.

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

In order for an event to be considered official, five (5) representations of equal number of National Olympic Committees shall participate. In case, after the celebration of the Technical Meeting, one or several representations are unable to participate due to force majeure confirmed by (CCS).

NATIONALITY

Any athlete participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the NOC country that registered them.

The competitor's nationality is determined according to the (CCS) Regulations.

7. REGISTRATION

All countries, through the respective (NOC), must send their Intention to participate in Sports and modalities in the official forms established by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on December 23rd, of 2022. The sports in which they are going to participate must be indicated in it, in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the forms will be published on the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

Required be done through the respective NOC and received no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on February 23rd, 2023, in the established format, presented before the organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION – LONG LIST

The “Nominal List - Long List”: of athletes, Team Officials, technical bodies, administrative and auxiliary personnel must be sent by each (NOC) no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on March 23rd, 2023.

They may register up to double the quota established for each sport. The Long List must be registered in the form established by the Organization to comply with the closing date, for any questions or clarification in this regard, the Organizing Committee puts at your disposal the email: inscripciones@sansalvador2023.org.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION

Required to be made in the corresponding format through the respective NOC and received before midnight (El Salvador Time) on May 23rd, 2023, presented before the Organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. The sports and gender in which they will participate must be indicated.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

Each National Olympic Committee (NOC) may register a maximum of twelve (12) athletes.

The maximum number of competitors in each individual event is 29, according to the classification system proposed by the Pan American Archery Confederation and approved by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

10. COMPETITION FORMAT

The XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, will be held in accordance with the statute of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), and the Regulations of the International Archery Federation (FITA) in force during the games.

Cases not contemplated in the above-mentioned Regulations shall be resolved in the following manner:

Cases of a general will be resolved in accordance with the statute of Centro Caribe Sports, and the Regulations of the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

Technical cases will be resolved by the Technical Delegate or the Jury of Appeals.

At least five (5) athletes or teams from equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate for an event to be considered official, as established in the (CCS) Rules of Competition.

12. TRAINING FACILITIES

VENUE: Archery Polygon "Jorge Jiménez" at Ciudad Merliot Sports Center.

Access shall be allowed only to accredited team members. Public shall not be allowed to enter. The equipment shall follow the requirements of the corresponding International Federation.

The facilities may be used only at the times assigned by the Organizing Committee; the training sessions will be held at the venue of the competition or at the facilities designated by the Organizing Committee.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Official practices will take place on July 01st, 2023, for both genders at a time to be confirmed.

13. SPECIFIC RULES

The competition system includes qualification and elimination rounds.

The qualification round for the recurve bow categories consists of one 72 arrow, 70 meters Round for both Men's and Women's. Book 2, article 4.5.1.7 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

In the case of compound bow, the qualification round consists of 72 arrows, 50 meters for both Men's and Women's. Book 2, article 4.5.1.5 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

The individual elimination round for recurve bow consists of games that are defined by set points in a simple elimination system, where the winner of each game passes to the next round and the loser is eliminated.

Each set consists of 3 arrows shot at 70 meters in 90 seconds in simultaneous shooting games, and in 20 seconds per arrow in alternating shooting games. The winner of each set earns 2 points, the loser 0 points, and in a tied set, each archer gets 1 point.

The victor is the first archer to total 6 set points. When a game is tied to 5 set points per archer, an additional arrow is shot and the winner is the archer with the arrow closest to center. Chapters 12, 13 and 14 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

Seeding in the simple elimination system corresponds to the place obtained in the qualification round (sum of the 72 arrows). Article 4.5.1 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

The individual elimination round for compound bow consists of games that are defined by the sum of total points earned in 15 arrows (shot in 5 sets of 3 arrows each). Competition is in a simple elimination system where the winner passes to the next round and the loser is eliminated. Each set is shot at 50 meters, in 90 seconds in games with simultaneous shooting, and in 20 seconds per arrow in games with alternating shooting. In case of a tied score after the 15 arrows have been shot, an additional arrow is shot and the winner is the archer whose arrow is closest to center. Chapters 12, 13 and 14 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

The team elimination round in recurve and compound bows takes place in a simple elimination system, where the winning team passes to the next round and the loser team is eliminated. Chapters 12, 13 and 14 of the World Archery Federation Rules. Each team compound bow game consists of 24 arrows for same sex teams and 16 arrows for mixed teams. Chapters 12, 13 and 14 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

Each team recurve bow game is defined by set points. Each set consists of 6 arrows (2 per archer). The set winner gets 2 points, the loser 0 points. In tied games each team gets 1 point. Sets in mixed teams consist of 4 arrows (2 per archer). The team to first reach 5 set points wins the game. Chapters 12, 13 and 14 of the World Archery Federation Rules.

If there is a tie in the sum of points (compound) or set points (recurve), a series of 3 arrows is shot (1 per archer in each team), or two arrows (1 per archer in each team) in the case of a mixed team. Time for a tie-breaker is 1 minute in same sex teams and 40 seconds in mixed teams. The highest cumulative points in the shoot-off determines the winner.

If the score is the same, the arrow shot closest to the center shall resolve the tie and the winner. Article 14.5.2.2 of the World Archery Federation Rules

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS JUDGE'S AND REFEREE'S

The technical officials and international judges will be designated by the Pan-American Archery Confederation with the following distribution:

10 International Technical Officials

3 Jury of Appeals Members

3 National Technical Officials will be appointed by the Salvadoran Archery Federation (FESTA).

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Appeals on decisions by one or several members of the Judge Commission must be addressed to the Chair Judge in writing. The appeal will be delivered to the Head Judge who after reviewing it, will submit it to the Chair of Judges.

16. AWARD CEREMONY

The awards will be made in accordance with the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

INDIVIDUAL EVENT:

First Place: Gold Medal.

Second Place: Silver Medal.

Third Place: Bronze Medal.

TEAM EVENT:

First Place: A Gold Medal for each athlete.

Second Place: A Silver Medal for each athlete.

Third Place: A Bronze Medal for each athlete.

17. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

It will be in charge of the International Technical Delegate designated by the Pan American Archery Americas Confederation (COPARCO).

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will take place on July 1, 2023, in place and date to be confirm.
- Up to two representatives of each NOC may attend this Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Mission Chiefs, at the Sports Information Center of the Central American and Caribbean Village from the day of their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Director of Archery Competition of the Organizing Committee (COSSAN) will chair the meeting, which will be held in Spanish with translation into English.

19. UNIFORMS

Competitors will wear their team colors and will abide by the International Archery Federation (FITA) regulations regarding their requirements.

20. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

Each (NOC) must provide its bows, arrows, and other accessories in compliance with the rules of the International Archery Federation (World Archery) contained in Book 3, Chapter 11, Articles 11.1, 11.2, 11.3 and 11.4.

21. DOPING CONTROL

The doping control will be made according to the regulations of Caribbean Sports Center (Medical Commission), the rules of the corresponding International Federation Standards and the in 2018 Version of the World Anti-Doping Program (WADA), will be followed.

22. SAN SALVADOR 2023 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

c) **Qualifying Tournament No. 2.** It will take place in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic from September 4 to 11, 2022.

In this tournament, those countries that failed to qualify as teams in the first qualifier may obtain team places, regardless of whether they have won individual places or not.

Individual places may be won by archers from countries that did not win individual places in the first qualifier.

A country cannot win more than one individual place in any category including both qualifiers.

- d) In both qualification tournaments the places won are for the country, and not necessarily for the archers who won them.

e) Qualification for Mixed Team events at the Games.

In the mixed team competition in both recurve and compound, all countries that have qualified at least one male and one female competitor in one type of archery are eligible to participate.

f) In each qualifying competition, each National Federation can present a maximum of 3 athletes in each category in which it aspires to win places either individually or as a team.

g) The National Olympic Committees shall confirm in written form to the Pan American Archery Confederation the places to be filled no later than a date that will be informed in due time. In case of decline or vacancies, the places will be reallocated to the countries that placed in the immediate next positions in the Second Qualification Tournament, as first rule. As a second rule, the Pan American Archery Confederation will define the countries entitled to such vacancies.

h) The Pan American Archery Confederation shall inform in written form to Centro Caribe Sports and the Organizing Committee of the Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023 the decision on the possible alternate countries so that the National Olympic Committees (NOCs) are able to accomplish with stipulated dates by Centro Caribe Sports for the nominal and numerical inscription.

(WILD CARDS)

The Pan American Archery Confederation will also provide one place by invitation in each individual category to countries with developing federations in order to achieve the greatest possible participation of Federations from the region. Priority will be given to countries that participated in the qualifiers and have not won places. As a second rule, an invitational place may be granted to a second athlete from a federation that has already won an individual place if it is considered that the level of the second athlete makes him/her worthy of competing in the Games.

23. SANTIAGO 2023 QUALIFICATION

- ✓ The best individual ranked athlete from a country that who has not won the quota places in the 2022 Pan American Championships. The athlete must be

located in the top 8 in the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American and Caribbean Games to be eligible for this place.

Female's Recurve (1 place)

- ✓ The best individual ranked athlete from a country that who has not won the quota places at the 2022 Pan American Championships. The athlete must have located in the top 8 in the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American and Caribbean Games to be eligible for this place.

Male's Compound (1 place)

- ✓ The best individual ranked athlete from a country that who has not won the quota places in the 2022 Pan American Championships. The athlete must be located in the top 8 in the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American and Caribbean Games to be eligible for this place.

Female's Compound (1 place)

- ✓ To the highest ranked individual athlete from a country who has not won the quota places in the 2022 Pan American Championships. The athlete must have located among the top 8 in the Individual Olympic Round at the 2022 Pan American Championships.

24. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Executive Committee of Centro Caribe Sport is broadly empowered to resolve any problem that is not contemplated in these regulations, in coordination with the Organizing Committee of the Games. Everything related to the applicable regulations, the promotion and advertising of equipment, materials and sportswear will be governed by the Promotion and Advertising Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports and Rule 51 of the Olympic Charter.
