1. ABOUT THIS MANUAL

Published in 2022, the Sports Technical Manuals provide detailed information on each sports competition and discipline at XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, as well as operational information that may be of interest to participating teams.

Each manual includes:

- An introduction to San Salvador and Games 2023.
- Sport-specific information, such competition schedule and format, training and qualification criteria.
- Operational information on accreditation.

While this information is correct as of the date of publication, it may vary according to the updates provided by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), the International Federation (IF) or Centro Caribe Sports (CCS). Therefore, National Olympic Committees (NOC) should visit the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com for updated information.

2. ABOUT SAN SALVADOR

San Salvador is the capital and largest city of the Republic of El Salvador and one of the most populous cities in Central America. Located in one of the fourteen departments of the nation, specifically in the department of San Salvador, it houses the headquarters of the three branches of government, the main companies of economy, development, telecommunications, embassies, hotels, Presidential House of El Salvador, the most important museums in the country, residential, economic and commercial areas, monuments and primordiales headquarters of economic, political, fashion, art and development services of El Salvador.

San Salvador is located at 670 meters above sea level. It is bordered on the north by the municipalities of Nejapa, Mejicanos, Cuscatancingo, and Ciudad Delgado, on the east by Soyapango, on the south by Panchimalco and also by San Marcos, and on the west by Antiguo Cuscatlán and Santa Tecla.

The geography of the Salvadoran capital is dominated by two great orographic prominences, which make the landscape of the capital unmistakable, since from any point of the city these can be observed: the Volcano of San Salvador and Cerro San

Jacinto. The first consists of two large formations: El Picacho, with a height of 1959.97 meters above sea level; and the other, El Boquerón, the most voluptuous formation, of 1839.39 meters above sea level, which has a huge crater of 1.5 km in diameter. This volcano is representative of the city, to the point that it basically forms its skyline (horizon), paling to any other structure built by human hand in the city, perhaps that is why despite some real estate takeoff that the town has experienced since the late 1990s, no structure has become i cone of the same, except for the historic buildings. The second most representative orographic structure of this municipality is the Cerro San Jacinto, which has a height of 1100 m nmand that until some years had a cable car at its top. The aforementioned San Salvador Volcano is located to the west of the City, while Mount San Jacinto at its southeast end. These two natural watchtowers frame the valley in which San Salvador sits.

The city has a warm climate all year round, with December, January and February being cool. Temperatures remain between 18 °C and 33 °C. The hottest are March, April and May. From May to October is the rainy season in which floods usually occur.

The temperature varies between noon and midnight due to changes in humidity levels. The highest temperature recorded in San Salvador has been 38. 5 °C, the lowest of 4. 0 °C.

5. PLACE AND DATE OF COMPETITION

The Badminton competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, will be held from June 25th to 30th, 2023 at the El Polvorín Complex.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, athletes must abide by the (CCS) statute and (BWF) rules and must be duly registered by their (NOC).

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

In order for an event to be considered official, five (5) representations of equal number of National Olympic Committees shall participate. In case, after the celebration of the Technical Meeting, one or several representations are unable to participate due to force majeure confirmed by (CCS).

NATIONALITY

Any athlete participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the (NOC) country that registered them. The competitor's nationality is determined according to the (CCS) Regulations.

7. REGISTRATION

Only the National Olympic Committees (NOC), recognized by Centro Caribe Sports, whose National Federations are affiliated to the International Badminton Federation, the Pan American Badminton Confederation and the Central American and Caribbean Badminton Confederation (CONCECABA), may register. Associate members recognized by Centro Caribe Sports may also participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

All countries, through the respective National Olympic Committee (NOC), must send their application for athletes in the official format to the organizer committee (COSSAN) no later than 23:59 hours (El Salvador Time) on May 23, 2023. The format must indicate the sports in which the National Olympic Committee (NOC) will participate. The forms will be published on the official website of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

The Numerical Registration forms, which indicate the number of participants in each individual and team event, must be sent to the Organizing Committee of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 (COSSAN) no later than February 23rd, 2023 before 23:59 (El Salvador time), in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

NOMINAL REGISTRATION – LONG LIST

The “Nominal List - Long List”: of athletes, Team Officials, technical bodies, administrative and auxiliary personnel must be sent by each (NOC) no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on March 23rd, 2023.

They may register up to double the quota established for each sport. The Long List must be registered in the form established by the Organization to comply with the closing date, for any questions or clarification in this regard, the Organizing Committee puts at your disposal the email: inscripciones@sansalvador2023.org.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION

Required to be made in the corresponding format through the respective NOC and received before midnight (El Salvador Time) on May 23rd, 2023, presented before the Organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. The sports and gender in which they will definitely participate must be indicated.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota set by (CCS) the Badminton competition will have a maximum of sixty (60) athletes in both gender categories.

Each (NOC) may enter a maximum of eight (8) athletes, four (4) women and four (4) men, as long as they meet the Badminton qualifying criteria for the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

The maximum participation per country is as follows

- a) Men's Singles Maximum 2 participants per country.
- b) Women's Singles Maximum 2 participants per country.
- c) Men's Doubles Maximum 2 pairs per country.
- d) Women's Doubles Maximum 2 pairs per country.

- e) Mixed doubles Maximum 2 pairs per country.
- f) Participation in the Team Tournament requires a minimum of 2 male players and 2 female players, the maximum number of members of a team will be 4 male players and 4 female players. No player may compete in more than 2 modalities in the same confrontation between countries

10. COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition schemes to be used will be are:

Mixed Team Tournament: it will depend on the number of teams registered.

Singles Tournament: Direct Elimination.

Team Tournament:

The National Olympic Committees (NOC) must confirm, by February 12, 2023, to the Organizing Committee their desire to participate in the Mixed Team Tournament, to be considered among the participating countries in this modality.

The Mixed Team Tournament will be defined from the number of teams registered.

Each Team match will consist of one (1) men's singles (SM), one (1) women's singles (SF), one (1) men's doubles (DM), one (1) women's doubles (DF) and one (1) mixed doubles (MXD).

A team will have, at least, 2 male players and 2 female players, the maximum number of members of a team will be 4 male players and 4 female players. No player may compete in more than 2 modalities in the same confrontation between countries.

The planting of the teams will be based on the results of the previous event, that is, the Central American and Caribbean Games, Barranquilla 2018.

If the Team lose the match for no show, then all of its results will be cancelled.

In case there is more than one stage of competition, during the preliminary stage, in a confrontation between countries, the 5 matches will be played; in clashes between countries during the final stage, when a country wins 3 matches, the confrontation will end.

The losing teams of the semifinals will compete for third place, the winner of the match will receive a bronze medal.

The Referee will be in charge of matches order between countries, taking the proposal of the participating Teams and the Regulations of competitions of the International Badminton Federation (BWF), its decision will be final on this issue.

The Competition Regulations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF) will be used for any consult that is necessary.

Singles Tournament.

The National Olympic Committee (NOC) must make confirmations with the following deadlines:

- Willing to participate with the assigned Quotas: January 17th, 2023.
- Reallocated places, will not accepted: 20th, January 2023.
- Confirmation of acceptance of quotas: January 26, 2023.

The seeding of the events of the singles tournament will be used the World Ranking of June 6, 2023.

The draw and competition scheme will be drawn up using the Tournament Software on June 13 and its publication will occur on June 16, 2023.

The Competition Regulations of the World Badminton Federation will be used for any necessary consultation to (BWF).

The Referee will be in charge of the match programme.

There will be no match for the third place of each modality, the losers of the semifinals will receive Bronze Medals.

Programs and courts for practices will be assigned by the Organizing Committee.

12. TRAINING FACILITIES

VENUE : El Polvorin Complex.

Access shall be allowed only to accredited team members. Public shall not be allowed to enter. The equipment shall follow the requirements of the corresponding International Federation.

The facilities may be used only at the times assigned by the Organizing Committee; the training sessions will be held at the venue of the competition or at the facilities designated by the Organizing Committee.

OFFICIAL PRACTICES

The official practices will be held on July 23rd, 2023 for both genders at a time to be confirmed.

13. GENERAL RULES

The competitions of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, shall be held in accordance with (CCS) Statute and the Rules of the corresponding International Federation (IF) in force during the Games. Cases not provided in the regulations mentioned above shall be resolved as follows:

- Cases of general nature shall be resolved in accordance with (CCS) Statute and with the Rules of the Central American and Caribbean Games.

- Cases of technical nature shall be resolved in accordance with the procedures of the Pan-American Confederation or the Continental Organism.

Cases of a technical nature shall be resolved in accordance with the Competition Regulations and Rules of the Games of the Badminton World Federation (BWF) and the Competition Regulations of the Pan American Badminton Confederation.

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

The Championship authorities will be designated by Badminton World Federation (BWF), as well as the Competition Directorate, according to the quotas officially established by the Directorate of the Games. It will also approve the accompanying referees from the participating countries, as requested by the COSSAN 2023 Organization.

The deadlines for nominations are:

The International Technical Officials will be appointed by Pan American Badminton Confederation: November 30th, 2022.

National Technical Officials will be appointed by COSSAN and the Salvadoran Badminton Federation and (DTI) but that should not pass December 31st, 2022.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals will be resolved by the referee on the court and in succession by the Referee.

16. AWARD CEREMONY

The Organizing Committee will only award prizes to the winners of the sports included in the official program, which will be in accordance with the stipulations of the Regulation of the XXIV Central American games and the Caribbean San Salvador 2023.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT:

First Place: Gold Medal

Second Place: Silver medal

Third Place: Bronze medal

TEAMS:

First place: A gold medal for each of the athletes.

Second place: A silver medal for each of the athletes.

Third place: A bronze medal for each of the athletes.

17. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

It will be in charge of the international technical D appointed by the Central American and Caribbean Badminton Confederation (CONCECABA).

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting will be held on June 23, 2023 at a place and time to be confirmed.

- Up to two representatives of each National Olympic Committee (NOC) may attend the Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Mission Chiefs, at the Sports Information Center of the Central American and Caribbean Village from the day of their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Technical Director of (COSSAN) of the Organizing Committee will chair the meeting, which will be in Spanish with translation into English.

19. UNIFORMS

The rules of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, and of the corresponding international federation shall be followed, and also the rules 51 of the (IOC), according to the regulations established for the (NOC´s) with respect of the used registered.

20. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The rules of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, and of the corresponding international federation shall be followed, and also the rules 51 of the (IOC), according to the regulations established for the (NOC´s) with respect of the used registered.

21. DOPING CONTROL

The doping control will be made according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (Medical Commission), the rules of the corresponding International Federation Standards and the in 2018 Version of the World Anti-Doping Program (WADA), will be followed.

22. SAN SALVADOR 2023 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Participation

Only the National Olympic Committees (NOC) recognized by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), whose National Badminton Federations are members of the World Badminton Federation (BWF) and the Central American and Caribbean Badminton Confederation (CONCECABA), will be able to register athletes in the Badminton competition of the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

Eligibility for participation

An athlete may participate as long as they meet the requirements established in the Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), the Badminton World Federation (BWF) and the Pan American Badminton Confederation.

Participation of athletes

The participation category is open.

An athlete may participate as long as they have complied with the registration procedures established by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

The combination of athletes from different countries is not allowed for the modalities of doubles, men´s, woman´s, and mixed.

Classification system:

- e) The host country will automatically be qualified with the full team of eight (8) athletes, four (4) men and four (4) women.
- f) Not allocated quotas (52) will be distributed according to the ranking position of the countries. The number of quotas allocated to each (NOC) will be announced, which will be calculated from the position in the World Ranking (WR) of December 27th, 2022.
The National Olympic Committees (NOC) will be notified for the allocated quotas before January 3rd, 2023.

Country's ranking will be calculated for points reflected in the (WR) lists of the athletes or couples best placed in each list of the World Ranking (individual masculine, individual feminine, dobles masculine, dobles feminine and dobles mixed).

- g) Qualification quota is for the (NOC) is not for the athlete.

Each (NOC) can establish own qualification system to participate in the San Salvador 2023 event under the requirements of (BWF) and (CONCECABA).

- h) The (NOC) must confirm the quotas, in writing to Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and (CONCECABA) before January 17, 2023.
- i) Countries that not receive maximum quotas (3 quotas or less) reflectin the acceptance document of the assigned quotas the interest in receiving extra quotas in case of having them.

In case of reallocation of quotas, countries that received three (3) quotas for men and three (3) quotas for women and, also probably (NOC) that received two (2) quotas for men and two (2) quotas for women, will be authorized to receive up to four (4) quotas for men and four (4) quotas for women, respecting strictly the ranking countries order.

This decision will be taken by (CONCECABA) and informed to the Organizing Committee no later than January 20, 2023, so that the favored (NOC´s) have the possibility of complying with the dates established by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) to make the numerical and nominal registration.

Approval of the Classification System

This Qualification System was approved by (CONCECABA).

23. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Executive Committee of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) is broadly empowered to resolve any problem not covered by this Regulation, in coordination with the COSSAN Games Organising Committee. Everything related to the applicable regulations, to the promotion and advertising of equipment, materials and sportswear, will be governed by the Promotion and Advertising Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and Rule 51 of the Olympic Charter.
