1. ABOUT THE MANUAL

Published in 2022, the Sports Technical Manuals provide detailed information on each sports competition and discipline at XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, as well as operational information that may be of interest to participating teams.

Each manual includes:

- An introduction to San Salvador Games 2023.
- Sport-specific information, such competition schedule and format, training and qualification criteria.
- Operational information on accreditation.

While this information is correct as of the date of publication, it may vary according to the updates provided by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), the International Federation (IF) or Centro Caribe Sports (CCS). Therefore, National Olympic Committees (NOCs) should visit the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com for updated information.

2. ABOUT SAN SALVADOR

San Salvador is the capital and largest city of the Republic of El Salvador and one of the most populous cities in Central America. Located in one of the fourteen departments of the nation, specifically in the department of San Salvador, it houses the headquarters of the three branches of government, the main companies of economy, development, telecommunications, embassies, hotels, Presidential House of El Salvador, the main museums of the country, residential, economic and commercial areas, monuments and the main headquarters of economic, political, fashion, art and development services of El Salvador.

San Salvador is located at 670 meters above sea level. It is bordered on the north by the municipalities of Nejapa, Mejicanos, Cuscatancingo, and Ciudad Delgado, on the east by Soyapango and San Marcos, on the south by Panchimalco and by San Marcos, and on the west by Antiguo Cuscatlán and Santa Tecla.

The geography of the Salvadoran capital is dominated by two great orographic prominences, which make the landscape of the capital unmistakable, since from any point of the city these can be observed: the Volcano of San Salvador and Cerro San

Jacinto. The first consists of two large formations: El Picacho, with a height of 1959.97 meters above sea level; and the other, El Boquerón, the most voluptuous formation, of 1839.39 meters above sea level, which has a huge crater of 1.5 km in diameter. This volcano is representative of the city, to the point that it basically forms its skyline (horizon), paling to any other structure built by human hand in the city, perhaps that is why despite a certain real estate takeoff that the town has experienced since the late 1990s, no structure has become an icon of it, except for historic buildings.

The second most representative orographic structure of this municipality is Cerro San Jacinto, which has a height of 1100 meters above sea level and that until some years had a cable car at its top. The aforementioned San Salvador Volcano is located to the west of the city, while Cerro San Jacinto at its southeast end. These two natural watchtowers frame the valley in which San Salvador sits.

San Salvador has a warm climate all year round, with December, January and February being the coolest. Temperatures remain between 18 and 33 degrees Celsius. The hottest are from March to May, from May to October is the rainy season, usually floods occur (especially in rivers). The temperature varies between noon and midnight, due to changes in humidity levels. The highest temperature recorded in San Salvador was 38.5 °C, the lowest was 4.0 °C.

5. PLACE AND DATE OF COMPETITION

The basketball competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023, will be held from June 24th to 28th in the Female's category and from July 1st to 5th, 2023 in the Male's category at the National Gymnasium.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must abide by the provisions of the Games Regulations and the rules of the International Basketball Federation (FIBA); he/she must also be registered by his/her National Olympic Committee (NOC) in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or test to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

In the event that one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable

to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023

NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

7. REGISTRATION

Only National Olympic Committees (NOC), recognized by Centro Caribe Sports, whose National Federations are affiliated to the International Basketball Federation, the Confederation of Central American and Caribbean of Basketball (CONCENCABA) may register. Associate members recognized by Centro Caribe Sports may also participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

All countries, through their respective National Olympic Committee (NOC), shall send their athlete applications in the official format to the Organizing Committee no later than 23:59 hours (El Salvador time) on May 23, 2023. The format must indicate the sports in which the National Olympic Committee (NOC) will participate. The forms will be published on the official website of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

The Numerical Entry forms, which indicate the number of participants in each individual and team event, must be submitted to the Organizing Committee of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 (COSSAN) no later than February 23, 2023, before 23:59 (El Salvador time), in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

NOMINAL REGISTRATION - LONG LIST

The "Nominal List - Long List": of athletes, Team Officials, coaching staff, administrative and auxiliary staff must be submitted by each (NOC) no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on March 23, 2023.

Registration is open until the quota established for each sport is doubled. The Long List must be registered in the form established by the Organization to comply with the Closing Date, for any questions or clarification in this regard, the Organizing Committee makes available the following email: inscripciones@sansalvador2023.org

NOMINAL REGISTRATION

In order for each eligible athlete to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, a Nominal Entry Form must be completed and submitted to the National Olympic Committees (NOC) and received by the Organizing Committee no later than May 23, 2023, at 23:59 (El Salvador time), in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of the Central Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

Each (NOC) shall submit its official Numeric Entry and Nominal Entry forms provided by the Organizing Committee 6 months prior to the Games.

10. COMPETITION FORMAT

CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

8 male's teams and 8 Female's teams will participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

The competition consists of a preliminary round, a semi-final and a final. There is a round of qualifying games for the fifth through eighth place Placement.

PRELIMINARY ROUNDS:

The eight teams will be divided into two groups (A and B) with four teams each. During the preliminary round, teams will be ranked in accordance with Article D - Team Rankings of the FIBA Basketball Rules.

PROCEDURE

- E. Teams will be ranked according to their win-loss record, i.e. 2 points for each game won, 1 point for each game lost, and 0 ranking points for a game lost by forfeiture.
- F. The procedure shall apply to all competitions on a round-robin basis.
- G. If 2 or more teams have the same win-loss record in a group, the game(s) between these 2 or more teams will decide the classification. If these 2 or more teams have the same win-loss record of games between them, then the following criteria will be applied in the following order:
 - a. The largest difference in points scored in games between tied teams.
 - b. Highest number of points scored in games between tied teams
 - c. Highest difference of points scored among all the games of the group.
 - d. The highest number of points scored across all teams in the group.
- H. If at any level of these criteria one or more teams are already qualified, the procedure of C will be repeated from the beginning for all remaining teams not yet qualified.

SEMIFINAL ROUNDS:

The teams ranked first and second in each group will play as follows:

SEMIFINAL 1: 1st. place in Group A vs. 2nd. Place in Group B.

SEMIFINAL 2: 2nd. Group A vs. 1st. place in Group B.

FINAL ROUNDS

The winners of the semifinal matches will play for the gold medal and the losers will play for the bronze medal.

- A. For first and second place: winner of Semifinal 1 vs. winner of Semifinal 2
- B. For third and fourth place: loser of Semifinal 1 vs. loser of Semifinal 2.

QUALIFYING ROUND:

In the qualifying rounds, the teams that placed third in each group will compete with the fourth-placed teams from the opposite group for the qualifying semifinals. The winners of these matches will participate in the match for fifth and sixth place and the losers will play each other for seventh and eighth place.

12. TRAINING FACILITIES

VENUE: Courts of the José Adolfo Pineda National Basketball Gymnasium. San Salvador. El Salvador.

The training schedule will be established once the numerical registrations are received and will be communicated upon the arrival of the delegations in San Salvador. The facilities may be used only during the hours assigned by the Organizing Committee and FIBA Americas; training sessions will be held at the competition venue or at the facilities designated by the Organizing Committee and FIBA Americas.

13. GENERAL RULES

The competitions of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 will be conducted in accordance with the Statute of Centro Caribe Sport, the FIBA Internal Regulations, and the FIBA Basketball Official Rules in force during the Games. Cases not provided for in the regulations shall be resolved as follows:

- C. Cases of a general nature will be resolved in accordance with the Statutes of Centro Caribe Sports and the Regulations of the Central American and Caribbean Games.

- D. Cases of a technical nature will be resolved in accordance with the procedures of the Central American and Caribbean Confederation or International Federation.

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

JUDGES AND REFEREES

FIBA Americas will appoint the Referees of the competition from its list of active referees. Each country will be responsible for bringing a referee (male or female) appointed by FIBA for each team, and the travel expenses will be paid by the respective Olympic Committee, the hotel, food and travel expenses will be the responsibility of the Organizing Committee. FIBA will appoint Referees from countries not participating in the Games.

The table officials and statisticians (NTOs) must have a FIBA license and will be appointed by the Host Federation. Travel expenses will be the responsibility of the Organizing Committee, as well as travel, hotel, and food expenses, if applicable.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Disputes will be settled in accordance with the FIBA Official Basketball Rules. The FIBA Americas President and/or his representative shall appoint the Jury of Appeals.

16. AWARD CEREMONY

The awards will be made in accordance with the Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) Regulations.

First Place: Gold Medal

Second Place: Silver Medal

Third Place: Bronze Medal

17. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

It will be in charge of the International Technical Delegate appointed by the Central American and Caribbean Basketball Confederation.

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

VENUE: The Technical Meeting will be held on June 23, 2023, at **TBC** at the University of El Salvador (UES) Females's Category. And from June 30, 2023, to the **TBC** at the University of El Salvador (UES) Male Category.

- Up to two representatives from each CONS may attend this Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available for Team Leaders at the Sports Information Center of the Central American and Caribbean Village from the day of their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Director of the Basketball Competition of the Organizing Committee will preside over the meeting, which will be conducted in Spanish with English translation.

19. UNIFORMS

Competitors will wear their team colors and will abide by the rules of the International Basketball Federation in terms of their requirements

20. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The Organizing Committee will provide the equipment for the competition, warm-up, and training. All equipment shall comply with the specifications of the International Basketball Federation.

The uniforms of the participating teams shall conform to FIBA game rules. Each team will present a minimum of two (2) uniforms, one (1) light, and one dark. Team colors must be indicated on the nominal inscription.

The participating federations must send the design of the uniforms in both presentations to FIBA's compliance department in order to be adjusted and approved.

21. DOPING CONTROL

The tests for Doping Control will be carried out by the Medical Division of the Organizing Committee. The current regulations will be those of the Medical Commissions of the International Olympic Committee, WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency) and Centro Caribe Sports.

22. CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM TO SAN SALVADOR 2023

Teams comprising the National Teams of member Federations shall comply with the eligibility requirements set forth in Book 3 of the FIBA Internal Regulations, as applied to FIBA and FIBA Americas events in accordance with Rules 1 and 2 of Book 2 of the FIBA Internal Regulations.

General Provisions

Players eligible to participate in FIBA sanctioned events must meet the following requirements:

- FIBA General Statutes and Internal Regulations.
- The Member National Federation is strictly responsible for the eligibility of its national teams and the players registered in them.
- The Member National Federation shall bear the consequences of any infringement of the FIBA Internal Regulations, Book 3, chapters 1 and 2, governing eligibility and nationality conditions. It is not necessary that fault or negligence on the part of the Member National Federation be shown in order to establish a violation by the Member National Federation.
- FIBA may request that evidence be provided to verify the legal nationality (or nationalities), identity, age, or other information regarding the status or behavior of any player that may be relevant to the application of the FIBA General Statutes and/or International Regulations and/or Zone Regulations, by requesting such documents as it deems appropriate.

Player Eligibility

- All players registered for this competition must have acquired the legal nationality of that country and have complied with the registration conditions provided in FIBA's internal regulations and be duly approved in the FIBA MAP.
- Eligibility regulation will be carried out in accordance with the FIBA Internal Regulations identified in Books 2 and 3. With this objective in

mind, FIBA has enabled access to the Administration Platform (known as FIBA MAP) to all National Federations.

Eligibility – Trainers

- Coaches submitted in preliminary registration (sent via MAP) must have a FIBA Coaching License to be eligible.
- Eligibility regulation will be carried out in accordance with the FIBA Internal Regulations identified in Books 2 and 3. With this objective in mind, FIBA has enabled access to the Administration Platform (known as FIBA MAP) to National Federations.

Delegations

Final Delegation List

At the Technical Congress, before the competition, the National Federations will submit to the Technical Delegate a Final List (in official form provided by FIBA) of the Delegation composed of:

- A minimum of ten (10) to a maximum of twelve (12) players from the players validated, approved, and included in the Delegation's Preliminary List.

Note: Each team may include a maximum of one (1) player who has acquired or claimed the nationality of the country after the age of sixteen (16) in its Final Roster of twelve (12) players. (Internal Regulations, Book 3, Article 21(a).

- A minimum of two (2) and a maximum of three (3) coaches (one of them must be the head coach) valid, approved, and included in the Preliminary Delegation List.

The National Federations will receive in advance from FIBA the list of players approved for the competition. Participating teams must print this list and make sure that the players and coaches have a valid passport and present it to the International Technical Delegate for verification at the Technical Congress.

All countries, through their National Olympic Committee, must carry out their registration process through the Organizing Committee's information system, under instructions that will be sent to each National Olympic Committee.

It is necessary to send your requests of intention to participate in sports in the official formats defined by the Organizing Committee. The sports in which the applicant intends to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2022 must be indicated.

As host country, El Salvador will automatically qualify. The rest of the teams will qualify according to the following criteria:

24. QUALIFICATION TO SANTIAGO 2023

Qualification for the Male's Pan American Games is based on the results of FIBA AmeriCup 2022 Brazil (top 7 male's teams), and Female's FIBA AmeriCup 2023 TBC (top 7 Female's teams).

23. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Executive Committee of Centro Caribe Sports is empowered to solve any problem not contemplated in these regulations, in coordination with the Organizing Committee of the Games. All matters relating to applicable regulations, promotion, and advertising of equipment, materials, and sportswear shall be governed by the Promotion and Advertising Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports and Rule 51 of the Olympic Charter.
