1. ABOUT THIS MANUAL

Published in 2022, the Sports Technical Manuals provide detailed information on each sports competition and discipline at XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador as well as operational information that may be of interest to participating teams.

Each manual includes:

- An introduction to San Salvador and Games 2023.
- Sport-specific information, such competition schedule and format, training and qualification criteria.
- Operational information on accreditation.

While this information is correct as of the date of publication, it may vary according to the updates provided by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), the International Federation (IF) or Centro Caribe Sports (CCS). Therefore, National Olympic Committees (NOC) should visit the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com for updated information.

2. ABOUT SAN SALVADOR

San Salvador is the capital and largest city of the Republic of El Salvador and one of the most populous cities in Central America. Located in one of the fourteen departments of the nation, specifically in the department of San Salvador, it houses the headquarters of the three branches of government, the main companies of economy, development, telecommunications, embassies, hotels, Presidential House of El Salvador, the most important museums in the country, residential, economic and commercial areas, monuments and the main headquarters of economic services, political, fashion, art and development of El Salvador.

San Salvador is located at 670 meters above sea level. It is bordered on the north by the municipalities of Nejapa, Mejicanos, Cuscatancingo, and Ciudad Delgado, on the east by Soyapango, on the south by Panchimalco and also by San Marcos, and on the west by Antigua Cuscatlán and Santa Tecla.

The geography of the Salvadoran capital is dominated by two great orographic prominences, which make the landscape of the capital unmistakable, since from any

point of the city these can be observed: the Volcano of San Salvador and Cerro San Jacinto. The first consists of two large formations: El Picacho, with a height of 1959.97 meters above sea level; and the other, El Boquerón, the most voluptuous formation, of 1839.39 meters above sea level, which has a huge crater of 1.5 km in diameter. This volcano is representative of the city, to the point that it basically forms its skyline (horizon), paling to any other structure built by human hand in the city, perhaps that is why despite some real estate takeoff that the town has experienced since the late 1990s, no structure has become an icon of it, except for historic buildings. The second most representative orographic structure of this municipality is Cerro San Jacinto, which has a height of 1100 meters above sea level and that until some years had a cable car at its top. The aforementioned San Salvador Volcano is located to the west of the city, while Mount San Jacinto at its southeast end.

These two natural watchtowers frame the valley in which San Salvador sits. The city has a warm climate all year round, with December, January and February being cool. Temperatures remain between 18 °C and 33 °C. The hottest are March, April and May. From May to October is the rainy season in which floods usually occur.

The temperature varies between noon and midnight due to changes in humidity levels. The highest temperature recorded in San Salvador has been 38.5 °C, the lowest of 4.0 °C.

5. PLACE AND DATE OF COMPETITION

The Bowling competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, will be held from June 28th to July 4th, 2023 at the Bowling Training Center of the Central American Village.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, athletes must abide by the (CCS) statute and (CONCECABOL) rules and must be duly registered by their (NOC).

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event to be considered official, five (5) representations of equal number of National Olympic Committees shall participate. In case, after the celebration of the Technical Meeting, one or several representations are unable to participate due to force majeure confirmed by (CCS).

NATIONALITY

Any athlete participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the (NOC) country that registered them. The competitor's nationality is determined according to the (CCS) Regulations.

7. REGISTRATION

All countries, through the respective (NOC), must send their Intention to participate in Sports and modalities in the official forms established by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on December 23rd, of 2022. The sports in which they are going to participate must be indicated in it, in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the forms will be published on the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

Required be done through the respective NOC and received no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on February 23rd, 2023, in the established format, presented before the organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION – LONG LIST

The “Nominal List - Long List”: of athletes, Team Officials, technical bodies, administrative and auxiliary personnel must be sent by each (NOC) no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on March 23rd, 2023.

They may register up to double the quota established for each sport. The Long List must be registered in the form established by the Organization to comply with the closing date, for any questions or clarification in this regard, the Organizing Committee puts at your disposal the email: inscripciones@sansalvador2023.org.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION

Required to be made in the corresponding format through the respective NOC and received before midnight (El Salvador Time) on May 23rd, 2023, presented before the Organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. The sports and gender in which they will definitely participate must be indicated.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota established by the Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), the Bowling competition will have a maximum of one hundred and twenty (120) athletes, sixty (60) women and sixty (60) men.

Each NOC may register a maximum of twelve (12) athletes, six (6) women and six (6) men, as long as they meet the Bowling qualification criteria for the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

The maximum participation per country per event is as follows:

- **Individual event:** 6 men and 6 women.
- **Doubles event:** 3 teams per category.
- **Trios Event:** 2 shortlists per category.
- **Quintets Event (Teams):** 1 quintet per branch.

10. COMPETITION FORMAT

Senior Championship: The teams will be made up of 6 men and 6 women and each Federation may register 1 team per gender.

- **Individual Event** 6 games each competitor.
- **Doubles Event** 6 games each competitor.
- **Trios Event** 6 games each competitor.
- **Teams Event** 10 games in baker format.
- **All Individual Event** 18 Games, adding the pins knocked down into singles, doubles, trios of each competitor.

12. TRAINING FACILITIES

VENUE: Bowling Training Center "José Antonio Guandique"

Access shall be allowed only to accredited team members. Public shall not be allowed to enter. The equipment shall follow the requirements of the corresponding International Federation.

The facilities may be used only at the times assigned by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN); the trainings will be held at the venue of the competition or at the facilities designated by the Organizing Committee.

OFFICIAL PRACTICES

The official practices will take place on June 27th, 2022 for both genders at a time to be confirmed.

13. GENERAL RULES

The competitions of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, shall be held in accordance with (CCS) Statute and the Rules of the corresponding International Federation (IF) in force during the Games. Cases not provided in the regulations mentioned above shall be resolved as follows:

- Cases of general nature shall be resolved in accordance with (CCS) Statute and with the Rules of the Central American and Caribbean Games.
- Cases of technical nature shall be resolved in accordance with the procedures of the Pan-American Confederation or the Continental Organism.

The development and control of the Bowling competitions will be in charge of the (CONCECABOL).

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

JUDGES AND REFEREE'S

The Championship authorities will be designated by International Bowling Federation, as well as the Competition Directorate, according to the quotas officially established by the Directorate of the Games. It will also approve the accompanying referees from the participating countries, as requested by the COSSAN 2023 Organization.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

All appeals of the decisions of the Administrative Committee must be made in writing with the Referee or with the president of the (CONCECABOL). Each appeal must be specific and will be accompanied by US\$100.00.

The jury of appeals will have the authorization to call for all the involved persons on the incident.

16. AWARD CEREMONY

The awards will be made in accordance with the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

First place: Gold Medal

Second place: Silver Medal

Third place: Bronze Medal

TEAMS EVENTS

First place: Gold Medal.

Second place: Silver Medal.

Third place: Bronze Medal.

17. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

It will be in charge of the International Technical Delegate appointed by the Central American and Caribbean Bowling Confederation.

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will be held on June 27th, 2023 at the "José Antonio Guandique" Bowling Training Center, a schedule to be confirmed.
- Up to two representatives of each National Olympic Committee (NOC) may attend the Technical Meeting.

- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Mission Chiefs, at the Sports Information Center of the Central American and Caribbean Village from the day of their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Technical Director of (COSSAN) of the Organizing Committee will chair the meeting, which will be in Spanish with translation into English.

19. UNIFORMS

The rules of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, and of the corresponding international federation Shall be followed, and also the rules 51 of the (COI), according to the regulations established for the (NOC´s) with respect of the used registered.

20. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The CONCECABOL regulation in its article 4.11.3 Ball Registration, states the following:

- Each bowler may register a maximum of 6 balls during the Event.
- Immediately after the official practice (not more than an hour after the last practice session) the balls to be used during the competition shall be registered.
- Up to a maximum of 2 Bowling balls may be added to the list of registered balls by a bowler (maximum of 6) throughout the Event.
- Any addition of balls to the list of registered balls of a bowler must be done at the latest 1 hour before the start of the session in which the ball(s) will be used.
- The replacement of a ball during the competition is allowed, according to international regulation.

21. DOPING CONTROL

The doping control will be made according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (Medical Commission), the rules of the corresponding International Federation Standards and the in 2018 Version of the World Anti-Doping Program (WADA), will be followed.

22. SAN SALVADOR 2023 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Classified:

- a) Host country, El Salvador is automatically classified with a full team of twelve (12) athletes, six (6) men and six (6) women.
- b) The remaining vacancies (108) were distributed in the Central American and Caribbean Senior Championship held in Guatemala City, Guatemala in 2021.
- c) In this event, 9 countries were classified in men and 8 countries in women.

Approval of the classification system

This classification system was approved by (CONCECABOL) in 2021.

23. QUALIFICATION TO SANTIAGO 2023

The discipline will grant three (3) places in Women and Men for the Pan American Games of Santiago 2023 as follows:

In all Qualifying Events the number of pins accumulated from the entire scoring event, of those of each Country, in the respective gender in singles, doubles and trios will be taken into account.

24. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Executive Committee of Centro Caribe Sports is broadly empowered to resolve any problem that is not contemplated in these regulations, in coordination with the Organizing Committee of the Games. Everything related to the applicable regulations, the promotion and advertising of equipment, materials and sportswear will be governed by the Promotion and Advertising Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports and Rule 51 of the Olympic Charter.
