1. ABOUT THIS MANUAL

Published in 2022, the Sports Technical Manuals provide detailed information on each sports competition and discipline at XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, as well as operational information that may be of interest to participating teams.

Each manual includes:

- An introduction to San Salvador and Games 2023.
- Sport-specific information, such competition schedule and format, training and qualification criteria.
- Operational information on accreditation.

While this information is correct as of the date of publication, it may vary according to the updates provided by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), the International Federation (IF) or Centro Caribe Sports (CCS). Therefore, National Olympic Committees (NOCs) should visit the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com for updated information.

2. INFORMATION ABOUT SAN SALVADOR

San Salvador is the capital and largest city of the Republic of El Salvador and one of the most populous cities in Central America. Located in one of the fourteen departments of the nation, specifically in the department of San Salvador, it houses the headquarters of the three branches of government, the main companies of economy, development, telecommunications, embassies, hotels, Presidential House of El Salvador, the main museums of the country, residential, economic and commercial areas, monuments and the main headquarters of economic services, political, fashion, art and development of El Salvador.

San Salvador is located in the central part of the country. Its elevation is between 600 and 1000 meters above sea level. Although the city itself is located at 670 meters above sea level. It is bordered on the north by the municipalities of Nejapa, Mejicanos, Cuscatancingo, and Ciudad Delgado, on the east by Soyapango and San Marcos, on the south by Panchimalco and also by San Marcos, and on the west by Antiguo Cuscatlán and Santa Tecla.

The geography of the Salvadoran capital is dominated by two great orographic prominences, which make the landscape of the capital unmistakable, since from any point of the city these can be observed: the Volcano of San Salvador and Cerro San Jacinto. The first consists of two large formations: El Picacho, with a height of 1959.97 meters above sea level; and the other, El Boquerón, the most voluptuous

formation, of 1839.39 meters above sea level, which has a huge crater of 1.5 km in diameter. This volcano is representative of the city, to the point that it basically forms its skyline (horizon), paling to any other structure built by human hand in the city, perhaps that is why despite a certain real estate takeoff that the town has experienced since the late 1990s, no structure has become an icon of it, except for historic buildings.

The second most representative orographic structure of this municipality is the Cerro San Jacinto, which has a height of 1100 msm and that until recently had a cable car at its top. The aforementioned San Salvador Volcano is located to the west of the city, while Cerro San Jacinto at its southeast end. These two natural watchtowers frame the valley in which San Salvador sits.

San Salvador has a warm climate all year round, with December, January and February being the coolest. Temperatures remain between 18 and 33 degrees Celsius. The hottest are from March to May. From May to October is the rainy season, usually floods occur (especially in the rivers).

The temperature varies between noon and midnight, due to changes in humidity levels. The highest temperature recorded in San Salvador was 38.5 °C, the lowest was 4.0 °C.

5. DATE AND PLACE OF COMPETITION

The Sailing competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023 will be held from June 24th to July 01st , 2023 in Ilopango, El Salvador.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023, the competitor must be subject to the provisions of the regulations of the Central American and Caribbean Games and must be registered by their NOC.

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

In order for an event to be considered official, five (5) representations of equal number of National Olympic Committees shall participate. In case, after the celebration of the Technical Meeting, one or several representations are unable to participate due to force majeure confirmed by (CCS).

NATIONALITY

Any athlete participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the NOC country that registered them. The competitor's nationality is determined according to the (CCS) Regulations

7. REGISTRATION

All countries, through the respective (NOC), must send their Intention to participate in Sports and modalities in the official forms established by the Organizing Committee (COSSAN), no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on December 23rd, of 2022. The sports in which they are going to participate must be indicated in it, in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the forms will be published on the official website: www.sansalvador2023.com.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

The numerical registration forms must be sent from the Organizing Committee of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games (COSSAN) as a deadline before February 13, 2023 in accordance with the provisions of the CCS Regulations.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION – LONG LIST

The “Nominal List - Long List”: of athletes, Team Officials, technical bodies, administrative and auxiliary personnel must be sent by each (NOC) no later than 23:59:59 (El Salvador Time) on March 23rd, 2023.

They may register up to double the quota established for each sport. The Long List must be registered in the form established by the Organization to comply with the closing date, for any questions or clarification in this regard, the Organizing Committee puts at your disposal the email: inscripciones@sansalvador2023.org.

NOMINAL REGISTRATION

Required to be made in the corresponding format through the respective NOC and received before midnight (El Salvador Time) on May 23rd, 2023, presented before the Organization of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. The sports and gender in which they will definitely participate must be indicated.

9. PARTICIPATION SYSTEM

Only the CON's recognized by the CCS, whose National Sailing Federations are members of the International Sailing Federation (WS, World Sailing) and COCECAVE, may register athletes in the Sailing competition of the XXIV Central

American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. If recognized by COCECAVE, members associated with the CCS may also participate.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota established by (CCS) the Sailing competition will have a maximum of one hundred and sixteen (116) athletes.

Each NOC may register a maximum of twelve (12) athletes registering a participation in each test as long as they meet the QUALIFICATION CRITERIA of the COCECAVE for the Sailing competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023.

If the quota of 116 athletes is not covered or is exceeded, COCECAVE will apply the criteria described in sections c) and e) of the Classification Manual, so that the maximum per NOC could be increased.

AGE OF COMPETITORS

Competitors must be at least fifteen (15) years of age in the year of competition (born in 2008).

10. COMPETENCE SYSTEM BOAT REGATTA

The technical details of the regattas will be explained in the race notice and instructions.

11. COMPETITION PROGRAMME

STARTING TIME OF THE REGATTAS

The intention is to give the starting signal at 00:00 hours every day of the regatta, from June 24 to July 1. All technical regulations, referring to the regatta program, will be specified in the notice and instructions of regattas.

12. TRAINING FACILITIES

VENUE: Club Corinto, Lake Ilopango

- Up to two representatives of each NOC may attend this Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Mission Chiefs, at the Sports Information Center of the Central American and Caribbean Village from the day of their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Director of Archery Competition of the Organizing Committee (COSSAN) will chair the meeting, which will be held in Spanish with translation into English.

13. GENERAL RULES

The competitions of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 will be held in accordance with the Statute of (CCS) and the regulations of the corresponding International Federation (WS) in force during the Games. Cases not provided for in the aforementioned regulations shall be resolved as follows:

- C. Cases of a general nature will be resolved in accordance with the Statute of (CCS) and the regulations of the Central American and Caribbean Games.
- D. Cases of a technical nature will be resolved in accordance with the procedures of the Pan American Confederation or Continental Organization.

14. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

JUDGES AND REFEREES

The technical officers and the international jury will be appointed by the International Sailing Federation (WS), according to the appendix in the Sailing Regulations.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The protests will be resolved as stipulated by the rule of part 5 of the sailing regatta regulations of the International Sailing Federation.

16. AWARD CEREMONY

The awards will be made in accordance with the CCS regulations.

17. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

It will be in charge of the International Technical Delegate appointed by the International Sailing Federation (World Sailing).

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

A technical meeting will be held on June 23 at 10:00 a.m. in Ilopango.
Up to two representatives from each NOC may attend the technical meeting.

19. UNIFORMS

They must comply with the Regulations of the Central American and Caribbean Games and the corresponding International Federation, as well as Rule 51 of the International Olympic Committee (IOC), in accordance with the rules established for the National Olympic Committees (NOCs) in the guidelines for the Use of Manufacturers' Trademarks.

20. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The Organizing Committee will supply the equipment for the competition, warm-up and training. All equipment will comply with the specifications of the current International Sailing Federation.

21. DOPING CONTROL

The doping control will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Medical Commission of (CCS)-, the Regulations of the International Sailing Federation and these will follow the standards and the current version of the procedures of the World Anti-Doping Agency.

22. CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM TO SAN SALVADOR 2023

1. El Salvador as host country will be automatically classified with a full team of twelve athletes (12) so that the remaining one hundred and twenty-five (104) places will be assigned to the other members of COCECAVE.
2. Each NOC will have one (1) quota (of its choice) in each of the sailing classes.

3. NOCs must inform COCECAVE and COSSAN 2023 of their participation in writing by January 26, 2023.
Unused places will be redistributed according to COCECAVE's analysis and notified to the NOCs, COSSAN 2023 and CCS no later than February 11, 2023, so that NOCs are able to comply with the CCS Regulations regarding numerical and nominal registration.
4. In the event that any event of one class does not meet the minimum of five (5) competitors registered as of April 10, 2023, it will be canceled and will not be replaced by another event, but the remaining quotas will be assigned to the other events up to the total of one hundred and sixteen (116) athletes.
5. The maximum number of places corresponding to each of the ten (10) sailing events convened is described below:
6. The quotas that are not claimed will be reassigned by the Classification Committee as follows, as well as in their absence the quotas that exceed the maximum of 116 competitors (except subsection e).
7. If necessary, there will be NOCs that can register up to 2 teams per test.
8. The priority will be given to one athlete/country for a class in which they have won a gold medal in the previous Games.
9. The remaining quotas will be allocated according to the results to the January 31, 2023, or the most recent available:
 - WS World Ranking if applicable.
 - Championships of the Region (with a minimum of three (3) countries) that have existed in the three (3) years prior to the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 with emphasis on the last eighteen (18) months.
 - According to what the Classification Committee judges, based on previous participations and places, as well as extemporaneous cancellations
10. Classification Committee
The qualification procedures and regulations will be the responsibility of the COCECAVE Classification Committee which is composed of two members of the COCECAVE Executive Committee appointed by its president, the Technical Delegate by WS and the Technical Director of the regatta of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.
11. The Classification Committee may modify the number of athletes in a class

23 SANTIAGO FEES 2023

The Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 are part of the Calendar that will have at its disposal five (4) female places, (4) male places and (1) mixed boat for the Santiago 2023 classification.

24 GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Executive Committee of Centro Caribe Sports is widely empowered to resolve any problem that is not contemplated in these regulations, in coordination with the Organizing Committee of the Games. Everything related to the applicable regulations, the promotion and advertising of equipment, materials and sportswear will be governed by the Promotion and Advertising Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and Rule 51 of the Olympic chart
