Qualifying period: March 1, 2023 – June 23, 2024

* BOA CT shall only be applied should no athlete meet the Olympic Qualifying Time or be invited by the IOC/World Aquatics to compete via an Olympic Consideration Time. If no athlete qualifies under the OQT or OCT + invite standards, universality may be considered as outlined below.

Universality: A maximum of one unqualified male athlete and one unqualified female athlete may be considered for selection for the Bermuda Olympic Team under the following criteria:

- The athlete has achieved the BOA CT or better at a World Aquatics-approved event
- The athlete is either the male athlete or the female athlete registered and eligible to compete for Bermuda who has achieved the highest World Aquatics Points Table score in any individual Olympic event.
- The athlete must have achieved said points score at a World Aquatics-approved qualification event during the qualification period, using the World Aquatics Points Table, 1st January 2024 edition.
- The athlete has participated at the 20th WA World Championships 2023 Fukuoka (JPN) and/or in the 21st WA World Championships 2024 Doha (QAT).
- If selected to compete for Team Bermuda under universality, the athlete must compete in the event in which he or she has achieved the highest number of World Aquatics points.
- After having achieved the BOA CT, in the event of a World Aquatics points tie, the swimmer with the next highest number of World Aquatics points in an Olympic event will be eligible for selection.
